

External Examiner: MSc Nursing - Advanced Nursing Practice

The School of Nursing at Ulster University is currently seeking an external examiner for modules within the advanced nursing practice component of above programme. Three pathways are to be offered: emergency care, primary care and children's nursing. The examiner will review modules relating to the clinical strands of this course. Attendance at one exam board per year will be expected, along with a visit to students in practice.

External examiners should meet the following criteria:

- Have current registration on the NMC 'live' register
- MSc qualification in Advanced Clinical Practice or Advanced Nursing Practice
- relevant experience of teaching, learning and assessing advanced practice at MSc level

The appointment will be from September 2017 for a period of 4 years. Appointments will be subject to the University's criteria for the appointment of external examiners. Previous experience is desirable but not essential as the university offers an induction programme.
